2020-2021 In-Person, Teacher-Led Instruction & Distance Learning Policy

Academy Adventures Midtown will begin offering in-person, teacher-led instruction beginning Monday, March 22, 2021, when we return from Spring Break in response to the Governor's Executive Order 2021-04.

To ensure that all students receive the best possible education, remain safe and are engaged in their education, parents/guardians are asked to choose which option they prefer for their child for the balance of this school year: In-Person, Teacher-Led Instruction or Distance Learning. Switching back and forth is not an option. Any changes must be discussed with your child's teacher.

In-Person, Teacher-Led Instruction Option

Per the Executive Order 2021-04, Academy Adventures Midtown will resume in-person, teacher-led instruction on Monday, March 22, 2021, when we return from Spring Break. Students will be back in the classroom with their teacher and peers. In addition to being in the classroom, students may be working in small groups and/or one-on-one with interventionists to help fill their gaps in learning. Students will receive breakfast, snack and lunch daily.

The school schedule will remain the same. School will begin at 8:00 AM and end at 2:15 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and 9:00 AM – 2:15 PM on Wednesday. Early Release Days will continue to be at 11:30 AM. Students may be dropped off 30 minutes prior to the start of school for breakfast.

Students will be required to wear their uniforms daily (there are NO dress down days). A uniform policy has been given to each family and must be signed and returned. The uniform policy will be enforced.

The school will follow all state and local recommendations to ensure that the school environment is safe for all individuals. This means that temperatures will be taken upon arrival (both staff and students), health screening questions will be asked upon arrive (both staff and students), everyone will be required to wear a face mask at all times and social distancing will be in place. Frequent cleaning of high touch areas will be done throughout the school day.

Distance Learning Option

For families who are not ready for their child to be on campus, a distance learning option is available. Your child will be required to participate at specified times during the normal school day (8:00 AM-2:15 PM Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday and 9:00 AM – 2:15 PM on Wednesday) and complete all assignments including, but not limited to: Packets, Workbooks, Assignments in Class Dojo, GoMath, SuperKids(K-2)/CKLA(3-5), SplashLearn, Reading A-Z and ABCMouse(K-2).

Most of your child's day will be an Asynchronous (offline learning) schedule completing assignments the teacher has assigned in the programs above and/or in workbooks or packets sent home. Your child can continue to use the Chromebook they were assigned at the beginning of the school year.
